THE SCHOOL

Founded in 1887, it is the oldest Catholic High School in South Jersey. Located on a 33 acre suburban campus the school includes multiple athletic fields, gymnasium, chapel, television studio, an auditorium and technology lab. A strong athletic program with more than half of the student body participating in the highly competitive Olympic Conference. For boarding students, the campus includes a three-floor dormitory just steps away from the school. Always popular, the Cherry Mall is less than one mile from campus. The school had \$6 million campaign: new dining hall was built and school has a new Leadership Academy. School's indoor track team won 2013 State Championship.
