THE SCHOOL

Montpelier High School located in Montpelier, VT was built in 1956 and remodeled and enlarged in 1998. The high school is co-educational serving 300 students. Students are encouraged to “be capable, motivated, contributors to their local national, and world communities.” The school was ranked in the top 2.8% of American high schools and the best in Vermont.
