THE SCHOOL

Opened in 1959 to serve the greater Burlington area and replace Cathedral High School which originated in 1917. The school has a strong athletic program with State Championships in Field Hockey and Soccer in 2014. School invested \$12 million for overall school renovations in 2014.

South Burlington borders Lake Champlain and is less than 100 miles to Canada. Part of the larger city of Burlington, it is also home to the headquarters of Ben and Jerry's. The Church Street Marketplace is a popular place for tourists and locals to shop and dine. Forbes magazine selected the city as one of the "prettiest" towns in America in 2010. Transportation options include the Burlington International Airport as well as the Rutland Railroad and a Greyhound bus with service to Montreal, Boston, and New York City.
